Dogs have been part of my life for many years. I showed my first one, a lovely Golden Retriever, when I was 14. He did well in the show-ring but, after him, raising a family intervened and our two sons had nearly left home, before I was hooked again! Our first PBGV arrived in 1997. Morebess Macho De Nice was a beautiful black and white, stubborn and naughty boy who soon



became a Danish Champion. Our second male won well at shows. Then, in October 2003, I had the opportunity to meet Gavin Robertson and Linda Skerritt who were visiting Denmark - and this was the beginning of a deeper love affair with PBGVs and forming long lasting friendships with breed enthusiasts worldwide, for which I am ever grateful.

Though having that stubborn male streak when in the show-ring, her son "Otto", Petit Heroes Canned Heat, has done equally well. He has 7 titles, 14 CACIBS and was 2nd Limit Dog at Crufts 2013.

Including England, I have travelled to many European countries to show my dogs. I am now qualified to judge all breeds in the FCI Group 6 and have judged several times in England, most recently Bassets and PBGVs at Windsor Championship show last year. Over the years I have taken on various roles in the Danish Basset Club, including secretary and currently newsletter editor. I am committed to health testing in our lovely breed and am pleased to be a member of the newly formed World Health Committee. I love my Petits and my life is very much one of going wherever they can be happy with me. This judging appointment in Tucson, for which I am grateful, gives me a wonderful opportunity to see more of our lovely breed and meet new friends. Patricia Trotter

I registered my first litter of Vin-Melca Norwegian Elkhounds in 1951 and had my most recent litter this year. My breeding program has produced the Top Sire and Dam in the breed's history as well as the breed's top winners. Vin-Melca Elkhounds won an incredible 10 Hound Group firsts at Westminster, all owner-handled. When Ch. Vin-Melca's Vagabond became Top

Dog All Breeds in 1970, he was the first amateur owner-handled dog to achieve that honor. I have handled my own dogs to Top



Ten All Breed status on 10 different occasions while holding down a full-time teaching job. The Vin-Melca Elkhounds were regular winners of Top Hound honors and awards.

Names such as Vagabond, Howdy Rowdy, Nimbus, Marketta, Silver Shadow, Voyager, Norseman and the current winner Delight are among the legendary hounds produced by the Vin-Melca kennels. Forty-one different Elkhounds carrying the Vin-Melca name and descended from that 1951 litter have accumulated all-breed BIS honors to date.

My achievements began early in life with Gaines Girl Show Dog Fancier of 1952. I won Winkie Awards as Breeder of the Year and Owner-Handler of the Year repeatedly in my campaigning years. AKC selected me as Hound Breeder of the Year in 2004 and as the Lifetime Achievement Award honoree in 2012. Other honors include the Pro-Plan Hall of Fame and two Fido awards-(Dog Woman of the Year and Dog Writer of the Year.)

As a judge, I focus on the true purpose of the dog show - selecting breeding stock. By working in concert with each other, breeders and judges can cooperate to contribute to continued improvement of the breed. I judged the 2009 Westminster Hound Group and the 2012 Best Bred By in Show at the AKC/Eukanuba Invitational. Two Vin-Melca bred Elkhounds have won BBE Eukanuba Hound Groups (2008, 2010) and a third BBE Eukanuba group winner was Vin-Melca sired.

Robyn Wallis

I have been involved with purebred dogs since 1972 having bred and shown Irish Setters and then Gordon Setters from 1974 under the 'Rokeena' prefix. After almost 30 years of successfully breeding the Gordons to many championship titles and having the satisfaction of knowing Rokeena Gordon Setters have been the foundation of a number of now successful kennels here and in NZ, I decided to downsize to a smaller breed. I imported my first PBGV to Australia in 2000. Since then with my husband Russell, I have imported 9 different bloodlines with dogs, bitches and semen to Australia, to help establish a firm foundation here for the breed. In the last 15 years, I have



produced over 45 Australian Champions and 7 Grand Champions and now 4 Supreme Champions. Internationally I have bred champions in New Zealand, Japan and the USA which includes the great Am. Ch. Rokeena Carte Blanche' who finished 2009 as Hound of the Year in the USA.

I have my judges license for Sporting Group, Terrier Group & Hound Group, Herding Group and Non Sporting Group and have judged all over Australia, NZ, Finland, Denmark and the USA.

I am very passionate about the PBGV and my greatest wish is to establish a strong, healthy foundation for the breed's future here in Australia.

I am very honored to be asked to judge the Regional and am looking forward with pleasure to my assignment.

AKC PBGV STANDARD

GENERAL APPEARANCE

The Petit Basset Griffon Vendéen is a French scent hound developed first and foremost to hunt small game over the rough and difficult terrain of the Vendéen region. To function efficiently, he must be equipped with certain characteristics. He is bold and vivacious in character; compact, tough and robust in construction. He has an alert outlook, lively bearing and a good voice freely and purposefully used.

The most distinguishing characteristics of this bold hunter are: his rough, unrefined outlines; his proudly carried head displaying definitive long eyebrows, beard, and moustache; his strong, tapered tail carried like a saber, alert and in readiness. Important to breed type is the compact, casual, rather tousled appearance, with no feature exaggerated and his parts in balance. Any deviation from the ideal described in the standard should be penalized to the extent of the deviation. Structural faults common to all breeds are as undesirable in the PBGV as in any other breed, regardless of whether they are specifically mentioned.

SIZE, PROPORTION, SUBSTANCE

Size – PBGVs measure between 13 and 15 inches at the withers. Height over 15 inches is a disqualification. Height under 13 inches is a disqualification at one year of age or older. Proportion - When viewed in profile, the body is somewhat longer than tall when measured from point of shoulder to buttocks, as compared to the height from withers to ground. Substance - Strong bone with substance in proportion to overall dog.

Head – The head is carried proudly and, in size, must be in balance with the overall dog. It is longer than its width in a ratio of approximately two to one. A coarse or overly large head is to be penalized.

Expression - alert, friendly and intelligent.

Eyes - large and dark with good pigmentation, somewhat oval in shape, showing no white. The red of the lower eyelid should not show. The eyes are surmounted by long eyebrows, standing forward, but not obscuring the eyes. **Ears** - supple, narrow and fine, covered with longhair, folding inward and ending in an oval shape. The leathers reach almost to the end of the nose. They are set on low, below the line of the eyes. An overly long or high-set ear should be penalized.

Skull - domed, oval in shape when viewed from the front. It is well cut away under the eyes and has a well-developed occipital protuberance. Stop clearly defined.

Muzzle – The length of the muzzle from nose to stop is slightly shorter than the length from the stop to occiput. The underjaw is strong and well-developed.

Nose - black and large, with wide nostrils. A somewhat lighter shading is acceptable in lighter colored dogs. A butterfly nose is a fault. Lips - The lips are covered by long hair forming a beard and moustache.

Bite - It is preferable that the teeth meet in a scissors bite, but a level bite is acceptable.

NECK, TOPLINE, BODY

Neck – The neck is long and strong, without throatiness, and flows smoothly into the shoulders.

Topline – The back is visibly level from withers to croup. There is a barely perceptible rise over a strong loin. Viewed in profile, the withers and the croup should be equidistant from the ground.

Body muscular, somewhat longer than tall. Compact, casual in appearance, with no feature exaggerated and his parts in balance. Chest rather deep, with prominent sternum. Ribs moderately rounded, extending well back. Loin short, strong, and muscular. There is but little tuck-up.

Tail - of medium length, set on high, it is strong at the base and tapers regularly. It is well furnished with hair, has but a slight curve and is carried proudly like the blade of a saber; normally pointing at about two o'clock. In a curved downward position the tip of the tail bone should reach no further than the hock joint.

FOREQUARTERS - Shoulders clean and well laid back. Upper arm approximately equal in length to the shoulder blade. Elbows close to the body.

Legs – The length of leg from elbow to ground should be slightly more than half the height from withers to ground. Viewed from the front, it is desirable that the forelegs be straight, but a slight crook is acceptable. In either case, the leg appears straight, is strong and well boned, but never coarse nor weedy. Improperly constructed front assemblies, including poor shoulder placement, short upper arms, out at elbows, lack of angulation and fiddle fronts, are all serious faults. Pasterns strong and slightly sloping. Any tendency to knuckle over is a serious fault. Dewclaws may, or may not, be removed.

Feet - not too long, between hare and cat foot, with hard, tight pads. The nails are strong and short.

HINDQUARTERS - Strong and muscular with good bend of stifle. A welldefined second thigh. Hips wide, thighs well-muscled. Hocks are short and well angulated, perpendicular from hock to ground. Feet are as in front. Except that they must point straight ahead.

COAT - The coat is rough, long without exaggeration and harsh to the touch, with a thick shorter undercoat. It is never silky or woolly. The eyes are surmounted by long eyebrows, standing forward but not obscuring the eyes. The ears are covered by long hair. The lips are covered by long hair forming a beard and moustache. The tail is well furnished with hair. The overall appearance is casual and tousled.

The rough, unrefined outline and tousled appearance of this rustic hunting hound is essential. Any sculpting, clipping, scissoring or shaping of the coat is contrary to PBGV breed type. The PBGV coat should be clean, neatened as necessary, but always remain casually disarrayed. Any deviation from the ideal described here and in the General Appearance Section of the official standard should be penalized to the extent of the deviation.

COLOR - White with any combination of lemon, orange, black, sable, tricolor or grizzle markings, providing easy visibility in the field.

GAIT - The movement should be free at all speeds. Front action is straight and reaching well forward. Going away, the hind legs are parallel and have great drive. Convergence of the front and rear legs towards his center of gravity is proportional to the speed of his movement. Gives the appearance of an active hound, capable of a full day's hunting.

TEMPERAMENT - Confident, happy, extroverted, independent yet willing to please, never timid nor aggressive.

DISQUALIFICATION - Height over 15 inches is a disqualification. Height under 13 inches is a disqualification at one year of age or older.

A Brief History of the PBGV Club of America



"Morebess Raymond le Rebelle" was the model for the club logo drawn by Vickie Kwasny. Raymond was from the first litter bred in Denmark by Per Knudsen in 1978. Declared the best show dog Knudsen had ever seen, Raymond won all over Europe, achieved many titles and Best in Shows and sparked demand for the breed in several countries.

Interest in the Petit Basset Griffon Vendéen in the United States was sparked in 1983 when George and Betty Barth entered Alexander, a 90-day-old PBGV puppy they had purchased in Canada less than a week earlier, in the New Jersey "Super Match" sponsored by the Professional Handler and Owner Handler Associations. Entered as a rare breed, Alex ended up winning Best Puppy in Match, and sparks from that one event turned into a wildfire of interest as

Alex's photo and stories about the breed hit the national canine publications.

Kitty Steidel had seen Alex at the match and later saw some PBGVs owned by members of the Basset Hound Club in Denmark. After doing much breed research and speaking to several others who were equally intrigued by the PBGV, it was decided time was ripe to form a club for the breed in the United States.

On Nov. 19, 1984, just a shade more than a year after Alex won that match, 17 people from eight states and Canada — Jackie Balog, George and Betty Barth, Sue and Bill Barton, Barbara Cromley, Geraldine Cross, Marc Delanier, Pat Fellman, Barbara Galbraith, Heidi Martin, Louisa Myers, Mary Jo Shield, Anne Snelling, Kitty Steidel, Sally Sweatt and Barbara Wicklund — met during AKC's Centennial Celebration in Philadelphia with the intention of forming a national breed club for PBGVs. With a stated mission to protect and promote this rough-coated French hound, the Petit Basset Griffon Vendéen Club of America was formed. Elected officers were Kitty Steidel, president; Barbara Cromley, 1st vice president; George Barth, 2nd vice president; Marc Delanier, secretary; and Bob Booth, treasurer. Bill Barton, Cross, Fellman, Galbraith, Miller and Wicklund were selected as board members. A letter was sent to AKC announcing the club's intention to seek recognition for the breed. During its first year, membership increased from those initial few to 50, a standard was devised, a constitution and by-laws were adopted and a national registry and studbook were set up. Four months after that initial meeting. 15 PBGVs competed in the club's first match held in Kentucky on March 16, 1985. Breed interest continued to soar, especially after ABC television reporter Roger Caras bought a PBGV and took it on "Good Morning America."

By the time the PBGV was accepted to AKC's Miscellaneous Class on July 1, 1989, club membership had grown to 126 and an annual specialty show was being held. On Aug. 14, 1990, the AKC Board approved the PBGVCA's bid to register its dogs in the AKC Stud Book beginning Dec. 1, 1990. The breed became the 131st breed to be registered and the 24th member of AKC's Hound Group, and became eligible to compete for AKC points in February 1991. By then club membership had risen to nearly 200, a number that was almost doubled for the club's 25th Anniversary Celebration which was held in conjunction with its 2010 national specialty in St. Louis.

PBGVCA NATIONAL SPECIALTY CLUB TROPHIES

For wins at the annual PBGVCA National Specialty; members in good standing only; with three wins (not necessarily with the same dog) trophies may be retired or replaced per club rules. Trophies are presented at the Annual Awards Banquet following the Specialty show. Once a trophy title is retired/reoffered "legs" on the award begin anew.

Please Note: Only PBGVCA members in good standing at the time of the Specialty are eligible to be awarded Club Trophies.

<u>BEST OF BREED</u>: The first Best of Breed Club Trophy was offered in 1990 by Anne Snelling. Helen Ingher retired the large, silver Westminster bowl in 1997 and replaced the award with a bronze PBGV. Nick Frost retired the Helen & Charlie Ingher BOB Trophy in 2001 and replaced the award with a large pewter plate on a walnut base . Gavin Robertson retired the Nick Frost, Dehra Kennels BOB Trophy in 2009 and redonated the award as the Gavin and Sarah Robertson, Soletrader PBGV Trophy in 2010. Donna K. Moore retired the Gavin and Sarah Robertson BOB Trophy in 2013 as the Don & Donna Moore, M & M's PBGV Trophy, replaced the award with a 10" Silver Plate on a wooden base beginning in 2014. The current memento is a walnut plaque (onto which their 8 x 10 win photo can be mounted).

BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX: The BOS Club Trophy is offered by the PBGV Club of Greater New York. It was first offered in 2008 and is a scallop-edged engraved silver plate on a large walnut base. The current memento is a walnut plaque (onto which their 8 x 10 win photo can be mounted).

BEST OF WINNERS: The BOW Club Trophy is offered by Debbie Perrot and Shirley Knipe, Hootwire PBGV in memory of Champion Lacebark's Lydia. The trophy was first offered in 2010 and is a large Dannyquest bronze standing PBGV on a walnut base. The current memento is a walnut plaque (onto which their 8 x 10 win photo can be mounted).

BEST PUPPY: The "Alexander" Memorial Trophy was first offered by George & Betty Barth of Gebeba Kennel plus fans of "Alexander" the PBGV puppy who won the NJ Supermatch and ignited the interest in the breed in 1983. The original award was a glass trophy etched with a likeness of Alexander. Jan Zigich and Ross Litman of Mirepoix PBGV retired that trophy in 2009 and replaced the award with an original stone artpiece on a wooden base etched with the same Alexander likeness. The current memento is a smaller replica stone.

BEST VETERAN: The Best Veteran Club Trophy is offered by Barbara & Gary Oxholm, Polygor, Reg. in memory of French/American Champion Fanfan De La Font Francaise. The trophy was first offered in 2006 and is a Dannyquest bronze reclining PBGV on a walnut base. The current memento is a walnut plaque (onto which their 8 x 10 win photo can be mounted).

BEST BRED-BY EXHIBITOR: The Bred-By Club Trophy is offered by Charle & Helen Ingher, Charlen, Reg. It was first offered in 2006 and is a bronze PBGV with puppies on a walnut base. The current memento is a walnut plaque (onto which their 8 x 10 win photo can be mounted).

WINNERS DOG: The Winners Dog Club Trophy is offered by Corey Benedict and Brent Humphrey, Sidekick Kennels in memory of Ch. Polygor's Sidekick Can Can. 
At the conclusion of Best of Breed judging, after picking Best of Breed, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, and Select Dog & Select Bitch, the judge at his discretion may choose up to 10% of the Best of Breed entry for an Award of Merit.

Obedience, Rally, & Agility Trial Policies

A qualifying score is required for all prizes in each class. Bitches in season shall not be eligible to participate.

AKC Refund Policy - Withdrawals after the event's closing date and time due to a change of judge must receive a full refund (no fee is paid to the AKC). Females in season must be fully refunded if withdrawn after closing and no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial. The Club may retain a processing fee as specified in the premium list.

PBGVCA Refund Policy - PBGVCA will retain \$10 (for expenses) from the first entry of a bitch entered in obedience, rally or agility, that is withdrawn due to being in season. If the bitch is on site, verification must be made by the Show Chairman or Chairman's designee. A veterinarian letter, on the practice's letterhead, will be accepted if submitted within the time frame designated in the AKC policy above.


