3 Point Major Reserve (National only)

Reserve Winners Dog and Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winners sex total at least twice the number required for a five-point major in the region in which the event is held.

Judge's Award of Merit

At the conclusion of Best of Breed judging, after picking Best of Breed, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, and Select Dog & Select Bitch, the judge at his discretion may choose up to 10% of the Best of Breed entry for an Award of Merit. Best of Breed, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch may not be considered by virtue of their already higher placement. The AOM percentage will be rounded up.

Grand Champion Points

At the judge's discretion, Grand Championship points may be awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog, Select Bitch.

2018 National Specialty Club Trophies

For wins at the annual PBGVCA National Specialty; members in good standing only; with three wins (not necessarily with the same dog) trophies may be retired or replaced per club rules. Trophies are presented at the Annual Award Banquet following the Specialty show. Once a trophy is retired reoffered legs on the award begin anew.

Please note: Only PBGVCA members in good standing at the time of the specialty are eligible to be awarded Club Trophies.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class - Will be for Stud Dogs and two of their get. Stud dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. Although the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the stud dog must be examined to determine if it has any condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for the breed. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class.

Brood Bitch Class - Will be for Brood Bitches and two of their Produce. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. Owner of Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the Produce. Produce only to be judged, based on the merits of the Produce. Although the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the brood bitch must be examined to determine if it has any condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for the breed. Produce must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class.

Brace Class - The two dogs with identical ownership comprising a brace must be named at the time of the entry, only a single entry fee for the brace class is required. If a dog, which is to be part of a brace, is not entered in a single-class entry, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only" for a fee of \$30.00. In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for each dog entered in another class and entered as part of a brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes as "Brace Class". If more than one brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH brace must be designated, Brace No. 1, Brace No. 2, etc.

Team - The four dogs with identical ownership comprising a team must be named at the time of the entry, only a single entry fee for the team class is required. If a dog, which is to be part of a team, is not entered in a single-class entry, it must be entered for "Team Class Only" for a fee of \$30.00. In making entries for "Team Class Only" full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for each dog entered in another class and entered as part of a team must be made accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes as "Team Class". If more than one team is entered by the same owner, the dogs accompanying EACH team must be designated, Team No. 1, Team No. 2, etc.

Pack Class (National Specialty Only) - Entry fee is \$30.00 per pack. The pack consists of an entry of at least 6 dogs that are all bred, co-bred, owned or co-owned by the exhibitor. The entry is made in the name of the kennel represented by the dogs as well as the exhibitor's name(s). The dogs are brought into the ring by up to 2 handlers, one of which must be the named exhibitor. The dogs will be judged on a point system with 120 being the maximum. Half the points (60) are allotted for how well the pack corresponds to breed type, and the other half (60) are allotted on size (30) and color (30) of the whole. The dogs are judged as a pack rather than as individuals; they are judged on type, size and color as a whole, they are not gaited. All dogs judged in the pack class must be entered in the regular classes. The judges shall choose one winner. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a pack must be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes. "Pack Class". If more than one pack is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each pack must be designated "Pack No. 1, Pack No. 2", etc.

Three Generation Pedigree Class (National Specialty Only) Entry fee is \$30.00 per unit. Each entry will consist of 3 specified PBGVs, dogs and/or bitches from 3 different generations, e.g. sire daughter grandson, in any combination as long as they are direct descendants. The 3 generations need not be consecutive. All 3 dogs must be bred, co bred, owned or co owned by the exhibitor. All three will be listed in the catalog. The entry is judged as a unit, with no one outstanding individual outweighing the quality of the others. All are judged on how well they represent the ideal of the breed standard, quality and consistency. The quality of each generation should meet or exceed that of the previous generation. The judge shall choose one winner.

All dogs entered in the Three-Generation Pedigree Class except the grandsire and/or granddam must be entered in another Regular or Non-Regular class at the show. If the grandsire and/or granddam are representing another Generations Class either as a Sire or Dam, then the grandsire and/or granddam MUST BE ENTERED in another Regular or Non-Regular class at this show.

NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Brace, Team, Pack or Three Generations Pedigree Classes is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged First in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

NOTE: Accordion gating or similar perimeter fencing will be used.

NOTE: The Show Chairman, Judges Hospitality and Transportation Chairs may have a dog entered in conformation but it must be shown by someone else. These people may enter & show in any of the companion or performance events (obedience, rally, agility, etc.)

- The term "dog" refers to either dog or bitch in both Obedience and Rally.
- Qualifying scores are required for all trophies and rosettes in the regular classes.
 Qualifying scores are not required for prizes in Non-Regular classes.
- Non-Regular classes are not eligible for the Special Obedience Trial trophies, nor will
 qualifying scores be awarded AKC legs or points towards Obedience Trial
 Championships.
- OBEDIENCE & RALLY MOVE-UPS WILL BE ACCEPTED ACCORDING TO AKC REGULATIONS.
- AKC Refund Policy Withdrawals after the event's closing date and time due to a
 change of judge must receive a full refund (no fee is paid to the AKC). Females in season
 must be fully refunded if withdrawn after closing and no later than one half hour prior
 to the start of the first class of the day of the trial. The Club may retain a processing
 fee as specified in the premium list.

All puppy entries in the Sweepstakes MUST also be entered in a Regular Breed Class. The Sweepstakes class should be shown as an Additional Class on the same entry form used to enter the dog or bitch in a Regular Class.

FRIDAY HEALTH TESTS & SEMINARS

Nose Work Seminar and Sniff & Go Match - At the 2018 National held in Reno, Nevada PBGVCA will be offering a "Getting Started in Nose Work" seminar followed by a Sniff & Go Match. Presenter Janna Moritz is the owner and head trainer of Fur and Feather Works in Reno. She has over 15 years of professional experience working with dogs, cats, parrots and other small animals using positive reinforcement training. She is certified by the National Association of Canine Scent Work to teach and judge Nose Work trials.

She will be showing you how to get your PBGVs started in the exciting world of Nose Work or as AKC calls it Scent Work. We will have working spots for 6 lucky dogs to try their nose at this new AKC canine sport during the seminar. There will be a small \$10 fee for the seminar and the working spots will be an additional \$10.

You may say my dog is too old, has physical limitations, is fearful or reactive to other dogs, has too much energy or lacks enough obedience necessary to practice and compete in other dog activities. Then you definitely need to come to this seminar and you will see and hear how Nose Work is designed to be accessible to virtually any dog.

The **Sniff & Go Match** will be held immediately following the seminar. It will include a container search where all dogs entered will search for the container with the scent of birch. Then all dogs entered in the interior search will start their search also with the scent of birch. There will be a charge of \$10 for each search. If your dog does not find the scent in the required time you will be given the opportunity to help your dog find it so they will end their search being successful.

Population Health and Reproduction - Dr.Bannasch- An accomplished veterinary geneticist, Danika Bannasch DVM PhD focuses her research on the identification of the molecular causes of inherited diseases in dogs and horses. Her laboratory has identified the DNA changes responsible for Lethal White Foal Syndrome, Hereditary Equine Regional Dermal Asthenia, Hyperuricosuria, Alaskan Husky Encephalopathy, Cleft palate, Cleft lip and palate, Spinal Dysraphism, Glioma susceptibility, chondrodystrophy and Saluki Spongiosis. Important research findings have also led to animal models used for similar human diseases. By studying naturally occurring diseases in animals, the Bannasch Laboratory is discovering a triad of significant advances: the development of diagnostic tests to aid animal breeders; the identification of novel genes and pathways as candidates for human disease; and an understanding of basic molecular mechanisms of disease.

TRIATHLETE AND BEGINNER TRIATHLETE COMPETITION April 24th – April 28th, 2018

In an effort to show the natural abilities and versatility of our little hounds PBGVCA will hold its 3rd annual Triathlon competition during the 2018 Reno, NV Regional and National specialties.

There will be two levels of Triathlete Awards available, the Beginner Triathlete Award and the Triathlete Award. To qualify for the Beginner Triathlete Award your PBGV must enter three different companion or performance disciplines (agility, nose work, obedience, and rally) and qualify in at least two of them. For the Triathlete Award your PBGV needs to qualify in three different companion or performance disciplines. Qualifying scores can be earned during Regional or National events. PBGVCA is hoping this award will help to encourage more owners of this wonderful versatile breed to enjoy working and training their PBGVs.

All participants will receive a commemorative token for entering the Triathlon. Each PBGV achieving the Beginner Triathlete Award or the Triathlete Award will also receive an additional prize.

DISCIPLINES AND CLASSES THAT COUNT TOWARD THE TRIATHLON

Agility – Standard or Jumpers in Novice, Open, Excellent, or Masters along with T2B all count towards the Triathlete Award. Regular or Preferred height.

Nose Work Sniff & Go – Passing the container search using birch as the scent will count towards the Beginner Triathlete. Passing the container and interior search also using birch as the scent will count towards the regular Triathlete Award.

Obedience – Beginner Novice counts toward the Beginner Triathlete Award. Novice, Open, Utility, Graduate Novice and Veterans (age 7 or older and must score 170 or higher) count towards the Triathlete Award

Rally – Novice, Intermediate, Advanced, Excellent, and Master Classes all count towards the Triathlete Award.

TRIATHLON RULES

- All PBGVs must enter at least 3 different events.
- For the Beginner Triathlete your PBGV must qualify in at least two different events. For the Triathlete Award your dog must qualify in at least 3 different events.
- The Nose Work container search and Beginner Novice Obedience class only count towards Beginner Triathlete.
- If your dog only Q's in two different events (must enter three) no matter the level you're
 qualifying scores came from your award will be Beginner Triathlete
- Only qualifying scores from the 2018 PBGVCA Regional and National events will count towards the Triathlete Awards.
- In Agility, Obedience, and Rally you must compete in a class that your dog is eligible for under AKC rules.
- Neutered and spayed PBGVs are eligible to compete
- ILP/PAL PBGVs are eligible to compete
- No additional cost to compete for the Triathlete Awards
